

## QUESTIONS FOR REQUESTERS

*We work collaboratively with people with lived experience of statelessness. This includes supporting individuals to tell their story in a way that feels comfortable, helpful, and empowering. For this to happen, individuals have to be in control of their own story and experience, beginning from the way in which they share it right up to how it is used once shared.*

*We've co-developed some questions with the stateless changemakers in our network, on things to check before going ahead with a project to share an individual's story*

- What's the benefit of this project to me, and to my community?
- How will you ensure that I have control over how my story and experience are used?
- Will there be remuneration for my time?
- How will you mitigate any risks to me in sharing my story publicly? Can it be anonymous?
- Will I be able to see the questions in advance?
- Will I be able to see the final piece before it is published?
- Will I be able to comment on the piece, including to flag any inaccuracies in the piece?
- Will I be able to ask for a change in details relating to my story and/or ask for information to be omitted before the piece has been published?
- Will I be able to sign-off my quotes if you will be using these in your final piece?
- Will I be able to use the final piece myself in my own work/activism?
- What's your policy on images?
- Do you have a full consent form?
- [For researchers] Can I see more details about your ethics process and approval?
